BURSARY

Two \$600 CPF-Delta bursaries are awarded every June: one to a grade 12 graduate from Burnsvie Secondary and one to a grade 12 graduate from South Delta Secondary. The applicant must be a member of CPF (an individual membership or a family membership), must have stayed in the French Immersion program (either early or late French Immersion), must demonstrate that they have participated in activities that promote French language education and culture, must respond to the short essay question in this application in a thoughtful and well-written manner, and must be in good academic standing (an average of 80% or better).

The applicant must also enclose a copy of their latest high school transcript. In addition, each applicant must have one of their French Immersion teachers write a paragraph vouching for their aptitude, participation and enthusiasm related to French studies, cultural activities, etc.

The bursary is payable once the winner submits proof of enrollment to a post-secondary institution by September 30, 2017, or earlier.
